
IN HONDURAS

Honduras has one of the largest rates for teenage pregnancy in Central America. For every 1000 teens between 15-19 years old, 66 are already pregnant. Some of these with their first child, others already having their second. We praise the Lord that abortion is still illegal in Honduras, yet this does not prevent moms from taking their child's life. For this reason, the Lord continues to lay a heavy burden in hearts to begin the pregnancy resource center upon returning to Honduras.
