*FOR THE RESTORATION CENTER ELISHEVA-We still wait on the city hall to give us the land that the mayor has agreed to give us for this ministry. Pray that wherever the papers are, God will bring them to light and by His hand He will move them forward and the land will be seen!

*FOR THE WORSHIP CENTER-We have around 20 kids involved right now and we need more volunteers! Pray for volunteers to rise up, not just from our church, but from others as well. Pray for November 24th as we take the kids to worship at a children's hospital here. Pray that through their worship children will be healed. December 2nd we will hold our final night of praise and worship for the year. May God be glorified!

*FOR THE SEXUAL ABUSE EDUCATION CENTER-More volunteers! Pray for contacts with schools to take the puppets and dramas that we have to teach prevention. Pray also as we meet with the Minister of Education here to try and get a curriculum established in the schools on a national level. Pray for November 17th as we do a night to raise funds and awareness at McDonalds. Pray for a 13 year old girl, named Lizeth, whose dad took her to the U.S. in May and began abusing her. Her mom came and talked to us, asking for counsel. Before returning to Honduras, Lizeth must face her dad in court. Pray for her to be brave and get the true healing that she needs.

*FOR THE PREGNANCY HELP CENTER-For volunteers. We will begin training January 14th, Lord willing. *FOR MORE HELP- Let us know if you are interested.

*Short term teams to help with marriage seminars, Bible teaching, dramas in the schools, evangelism, etc. *Interns-to help for a 3-12 month period or longer.
